**U19's (Cadets ages 16-18 years) excluding 19 year olds**

- Randori-no-Kata (17 techniques)
- Tanto Kakarigeiko
- Ninindori (three person team)

- Women's Tanto Randori

## Senior Events (must be over 18 years of age i.e. 19 years old)

- Junanhon/Randori no Kata (Kyu Grade only- any grade - 1-17)
- Tanto Junanahon/Tanto Randori no Kata (Dan Grade only 1-17)
- Jiju Embu/Open Kata (duration 2 minutes)
- Goshin no Kata/Koryu Dai San Kata (1-16 techniques Suwara Waza and Tachi Waza)
- Women's Team Tanto Randori (three women 3 Kyu and above)
- Women's Individual Tanto Randori (3 Kyu and above)
- Men's individual Tanto Randori (3 Kyu and above)
- Mens's Team Tanto Randori (five man 3 Kyu and above))
- Kongo dan taisen (seven members)

Event 1: Embu 1-8 Goshin no Kata/Koryu Dai San (Suwara Waza) minimum 16 years

Event 2: Embu 9-16 Goshin no Kata/Koryu Dai San (Tachi Waza) minimum 16 years

Event 3: Tanto Tai Sabaki – women only – minimum 16 years old

Event 4: Toshu Randori – men only - minimum 18 years old

Event 5: Tanto Randori- men only - minimum 18 years old

## Rules, Regulations and formats

Junior, Youth and Cadet rules will follow the already established European and British formats that have developed since 1977, The senior rules will follow the existing International format and rules (Brown Book). Both sets of rules and regulations will be sent to all participant groups and posted on the WSAF Website [www.wsafaikido.org](http://www.wsafaikido.org).

The senior rules will follow the existing international format and Aikido Randori Rules (Regulations and Referee Signals - revised 30th Aug 2008 JAA)

## Participation

The event is open to all Aikidoka and groups irrespective of association; affiliation or the style of Aikido practiced and is a truly an "open" competition.

## Team Points

The competition is open to all groups and associations irrespective of style or affiliation. Team points for 1<sup>st</sup> (3 points), 2<sup>nd</sup> (2 points) and 3<sup>rd</sup> (1 point) place positions will be allocated to the participant's country of origin/residence, the WSAF recognises Nation States as the core participants of the event.

## General Clarifications

- In all competitions the eldest participant will determine which age group can be entered.
- In Kongo dan taisen 16 years + is acceptable for Embu/Tai Sabaki events and 18+ for Randori .
- Players 18 years to 19 years can enter either the cadet or senior events but not both.
- In Senior competition players can only enter a maximum of two embu events.
- In Senior competition the minimum grade is 3 Kyu (Green).

## Entry Fee

This is a standard flat entry fee, irrespective of the number of events entered.
